

â€œPassword is incorrectâ€• when the Host is a workgroup computer and Windows Security Management

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If the Host is installed on a non-domain (workgroup) machine and you have selected Windows Security Management machineâ€™s local users and groups. You can make use of these local Windows user accounts to differentiate the to authenticate through Netop Remote Control using one of these local accounts (by typing in username, password, incorrectâ€• error message. The only account that you can make use of is the built-in account named Guest, provided configuration.

The reason for the "Password is incorrect" message is a setting in the Host computerâ€™s local security policy machine Sharing and security model for local accountsâ€•. By default, on non-domain machines, it is set to â€œGuest onlyâ€• to the Guest account. If this option is changed to â€œClassicâ€•, network logons that use local account credentials Windows accounts that have been added to security roles in the Host will now start functioning correctly when used

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
