Workaround: On the Netop Host running on Linux, open Netop Host Manager (from Tools > Options, enter the account for changing the Host configuration and click OK). Guest Configuration > Host Computer > Addresslists branch and add the Netop Security Server IP. Go to Local Configuration > Host Computer > Communication branch > UDP and create a new entry in the broadcastlist addresslist that contains the NSS IP. NOTE: To ensure that changes have been applied, restart Netop Host after the changes.
